Brief Bio-sketches of presenters

Dr. Aditi Haldar, has her PhD in Environmental Sciences and currently working as a Counsellor at the Confederation of Indian Industry in the Environmental Management Division, New Delhi India. She has over 14 years experience in the area of environmental sciences and sustainable development. In her current position she is responsible for program development and implementation in areas of sustainable management.

Ambreen Waheed, Founder and Executive Director of Responsible Business Initiative (RBI) is among the country's first qualified social auditors. Founding member of the SAARC Alliance for Responsible Business and the Asia Pacific CSR Centre Group, Ambreen's research with Cambridge University outlined a framework for assessing Socially Responsible Behaviour in Pakistan's sports industry. She has developed and introduced CSR as a teaching subject to Pakistani Business schools.

Hammad Naqi Khan, is currently working for WWF - Pakistan as Director, Freshwater & Toxics Programme. His responsibilities at WWF include development, implementation and supervision of pollution abatement projects. Mr. Khan is also responsible for the review of environmental policies, legislation and environmental impact assessment. He has played an instrumental role in initiating Pakistan Environmental Reporting Awards in the country and has participated in Global Reporting Initiative working groups.
